§ 111-1. Maintenance, location and marking.

There shall be maintained on private property held open or devoted to public use one or more fire lanes to provide unimpeded ingress and egress for Fire Department vehicles, equipment and personnel of at least 12 feet in width. Said lanes shall be laid out by the property owners after consultation with the fire company and shall be so located as to provide convenient access to the buildings and the fire hydrants servicing said buildings. The lanes shall be marked in any way as to provide reasonable notice to members of the public of the existence of said lanes.

Any person or persons who shall obstruct or cause to be obstructed a fire lane shall be guilty of a violation of this chapter and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$10 if paid within 48 hours after apprehension or \$25 if paid more than 48 hours after apprehension, and costs of prosecution.
