ARTICLE I Disorderly Conduct [Adopted 7-22-1963 by Ord. No. 653, approved 7-23-1963]

§ 147-1. Enumeration of offenses.

Disorderly conduct is hereby prohibited within the Borough of Camp Hill. Any person who shall be guilty of any act, word or conduct causing or tending to cause a disturbance of the peace and good order of the Borough or causing or tending to cause any danger, discomfort or annoyance to any of the inhabitants of the Borough or users of the Borough thoroughfares or who shall willfully make any loud, boisterous or unseemly noise or disturbance or who shall fight or quarrel or incite others to fight or quarrel or who shall publicly make use of obscene or indecent language or who shall loaf or loiter or congregate upon any of the public streets or alleys or public grounds in the Borough to the annoyance of peaceable residents nearby or traveling upon any street or alley or being lawfully upon any of the public grounds in the Borough shall be guilty of disorderly conduct.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof before the District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$300, and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 30 days.

ARTICLE II

Vandalism**[Adopted 11-14-1966 by Ord. No. 728, approved 11-14-1966]****§ 147-3. Malicious mischief offenses.**

Whoever maliciously damages, defaces, destroys, kills, paints, marks, breaks or injures any of the following property within the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, shall be guilty of the offense of malicious mischief to public property of the Borough:

- A. Any sign erected, placed or attached on or to any public ground, including but not limited to parks, streets, buildings and grounds, whether for the purpose of traffic control or for some other purpose.
- B. Any public structure of the Borough, including but not limited to fences, underpasses, buildings, garages, sheds, lighting fixtures or fire hydrants.
- C. Any public property of the Borough, including but not limited to vehicles, machines, tools and benches.
- D. Any growing thing on any of the public ground of the Borough, including but not limited to trees, shrubbery, hedges and flowers.

§ 147-4. Violations and penalties. [Amended 12-9-1987 by Ord. No. 891, approved 12-9-1987]

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction before the District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$300, and costs of prosecution, and in default thereof, be sentenced to undergo imprisonment in the Cumberland County Jail for not more than 30 days.
