#### ARTICLE I Firearms

##### § 195-1. Discharge of firearms prohibited.

No person shall, except in necessary defense of person or property, fire or discharge any gun or other firearm or any air rifle, BB gun or gas-propelled gun or pistol within the Borough of Camp Hill.

##### § 195-2. Violations and penalties. [Amended 3-10-1970 by Ord. No. 774, approved 3-10-1970; 12-9-1987 by Ord. No. 891, approved 12-9-1987]

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof before the District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300, and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 30 days.

#### ARTICLE II Bows and Arrows

##### § 195-3. Shooting restricted.

No person shall shoot an arrow from a bow or similar device at any place within the limits of the Borough of Camp Hill at any time, except at the archery range provided for such purposes in the Christian L. Seibert Memorial Park.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof before the District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300, and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, to suffer imprisonment in the Cumberland County Jail for not more than 30 days.
