§ 23-1. Establishment, membership and terms. [Amended 7-22-1963 by Ord. No. 641, approved 7-23-1963]

A Board of Health is hereby provided for the Borough of Camp Hill, to be composed of five members, at least one of whom shall be a reputable physician of not less than two years' experience in the practice of his profession. The members of said Board shall be appointed by the Borough Council, one member to be appointed to serve for one year, one for two years, one for three years, one for four years and one for five years, and, thereafter, one member, in like manner, shall be appointed each year, to serve for five years. The members of the Board of Health shall be residents of the Borough of Camp Hill and shall serve without compensation, provided that if any member of the Board shall be elected to the office of Secretary of the Board of Health, he shall be entitled to receive a salary fixed by the Board for that office.

§ 23-2. Appropriation for expenditures.

The Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill shall make an appropriation for the lawful expenses of said Board of Health upon the submission of an estimate by the Board of Health of the probable expenditures of the Board during the ensuing year.

§ 23-3. Laws governing Board. [Amended 7-22-1963 by Ord. No. 641, approved 7-23-1963]

The Board of Health shall be governed in all its transactions by the provisions of the Borough Code and other laws applicable to Boards of Health in Boroughs.¹
