§ 29-1. Library designated to provide public library service.

The Borough Council hereby authorizes and designates the Library to act as the legal agent of the Borough of Camp Hill to provide public library service to residents and taxpayers of the Borough for and on behalf of the Borough of Camp Hill.

§ 29-2. Maintenance by Borough.

The Borough Council hereby agrees to maintain or assist in the maintenance of the Camp Hill Public Library in accord with the provisions of Section 401 of the Library Code, the Act of June 14, 1961, P.L. 324.¹

§ 29-3. Representatives on Board of Directors.

In accord with Section 411 of the Library Code,² the Borough Council and Mayor shall appoint two people to serve as its representatives on the Board of Directors of the Camp Hill Public Library, each representative to serve three years, the terms to expire in different years. Subsequent vacancies are to be filled by people appointed by the Mayor and Council.

§ 29-4. Treasurer's bond.

In accord with Section 412 of the Library Code,³ the Treasurer of the Board of Directors of the Library shall give bond to the municipality with satisfactory surety in such amount as the Board of Directors of the Library may determine.

§ 29-5. Annual report and audit.

In accord with Section 413 of the Library Code,⁴ the Board of Directors of the Library shall present a financial report to the Borough of Camp Hill annually, and the Borough of Camp Hill shall arrange to have the accounts of the Treasurer of the Board of Directors of the Library audited annually as in the case of other municipal expenditures.

§ 29-6. Duties of Board.

The Board of Directors of the Library shall prepare and present to the Borough of Camp Hill such reports as are required by Section 414 of the Library Code⁵ and shall give free library service to the residents and taxpayers of the Borough of Camp Hill as provided in Section 415 of the Library Code.⁶
