ARTICLE I
Compensation for Services
[Adopted 2-10-1999 by Ord. No. 975, approved 2-10-1999]

§ 58-1. Imposition of fee for tax status certifications; retention by Tax Collector.

If the Tax Collector of the Borough of Camp Hill agrees to provide written information concerning the status of taxes to other(s) than the person to whom such taxes are billed, the Borough of Camp Hill does hereby impose a fee to be established from time to time by resolution of Borough Council for each certification or other indication of the status of payment; and, further, sums so received by the Tax Collector shall be retained by her or him as compensation for such service.

§ 58-2. Fees retained as additional compensation.

The revenue and fees herein referred to are in addition to the base compensation heretofore established for the services of the elected Tax Collector of the Borough of Camp Hill as may from time to time be adjusted.

§ 58-3. Reports; evaluation; compliance with state and federal regulations.

At least annually, the aforesaid fees shall be reported to the Borough Manager so that evaluation of their appropriateness may be made by Borough Council and compliance with state and federal revenue taxing regulations can be complied with.

ARTICLE II
Tax Certifications

§ 58-4. Designated officer.

The Tax Collector, a municipal officer, is hereby appointed as the officer authorized to provide tax certifications upon request by the public.

§ 58-5. Fees.

The Tax Collector is authorized to assess, collect and retain, as compensation for providing such additional service, a reasonable fee for each certification, which fee shall be determined from time to time by resolution of the Borough Council.
