**§ 86-1. Burials restricted to cemetery. [Amended 12-9-1987 by Ord. No. 891, approved 12-9-1987]**

From and after the passage of this chapter, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to bury or inter any deceased person or to aid, assist or be connected or concerned with any such burial or interment within the corporate limits of the Borough of Camp Hill, Pennsylvania: excepting, however, from the provisions of this chapter those sections of the burial grounds of the Camp Hill Cemetery in which burials or interments have heretofore been made.

**§ 86-2. Violations and penalties. [Amended 3-10-1970 by Ord. No. 774, approved 3-10-1970; 12-9-1987 by Ord. No. 891, approved 12-9-1987]**

Any person, firm or corporation violating or assisting in the violation of any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof before the District Justice, for each and every such offense, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300, and costs of suit, and in default of payment thereof, shall be committed to the jail of the County of Cumberland for a period not exceeding 30 days.

**§ 86-3. Removal of bodies illegally buried. [Amended 12-9-1987 by Ord. No. 891, approved 12-9-1987]**

Any body of any deceased person buried within said restricted territory in violation of the provisions of this chapter shall forthwith be removed at the direction of the Mayor of said Borough to some suitable place of interment within the limits of said Borough where lawful burials may be made, or without the limits of said Borough, and be there reburied or reinterred, and any costs or expenses for so doing, including the purchase of a lot or site for burial, shall be recoverable from the person or persons who buried the same in violation of the provisions of this chapter, jointly and severally, in a proceeding in the name of the Borough, as debts are, by law, collected.

**§ 86-4. Additional remedies. [Amended 12-9-1987 by Ord. No. 891, approved 12-9-1987]**

For the purpose of carrying into full force and effect the provisions of this chapter, in addition to and supplementing the penalties and remedies hereinbefore provided, the Mayor of the Borough is authorized, empowered and directed, in the name of the Borough, to institute

proceedings in equity to enjoin or restrain the burial or interment of deceased persons within said Borough, excepting those sections of the burial grounds of the Camp Hill Cemetery in which burials or interments have heretofore been made, or to require the removal of any such as may be buried or interred therein in violation of the provisions of this chapter and, in so doing, to do any act or thing in the name of the Borough necessary or required or deemed advisable in connection therewith.
