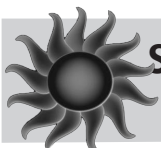

**Susan Dickey - Chairperson - 732-4615**

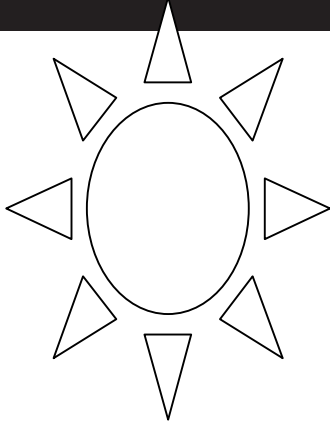
