Pat reported that mirror has arrived and will be installed soon. The crosswalk light system at 21st and Walnut is under construction and nearing completion. Pat will be the point of contact between BFC and the Boro.

Bob and Luisa reported about their vision of a CCT segment between Siebert and Ridley Park. They will try to get more East Pennsboro residents involved in the project. Proposed path is already a sewer easement.

The ENG group is currently working on the following:

Bike racks for businesses along Market Street and other yet to be determined locations: Legal issues have been resolved. We will order more bikeracks to be able to offer to businesses. We will also order more bike racks for Seibert Park to be installed near the basketball courts. Matt will provide details to Pat. Brochure is almost ready, Audrey and Bill will finalize. Matt will advise business owners on placement of racks.

Sharrows on Market Street: Pat to check with a contact he has about sharrows and signage for market street, Chief Hockenberry thought these could not be done. Engineering group feels these would be in compliance with PennDOT publications.

Bike racks at CH schools – This will be revisited with the schools once a new Superintendent is appointed by the schools. Previous efforts have not been warmly received by the CHSD. Questions over maintenance and other matters made conversations stall.

Carl recommended that Tim or Carl review the Bicycle Friendly Criteria and assess where we are and if we've made any progress.
