

**CAMP HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE REORGANIZATION MEETING
2145 WALNUT ST. PROSSER HALL
CAMP HILL, PA 17011
January 3, 2006**

Mayor Morrow called the public meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Present were:

Richard McBride
Brian Musselman

Also present were District Justice Manlove, Solicitor J. Stephen Feinour, Tax Collector Janet Miller, Borough Manager Gary Kline and Borough Operations Manager Anne Shambaugh. Mr. McLemore was unable to attend the meeting due to the death of his father.

- Upon a motion by Mr. McBride, seconded by Mr. Buell, that Borough Council acknowledge with sympathy the passing of Burke's father and we dedicate a brick in his honor to be placed at Borough park. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Kline was asked to write a letter of sympathy from Borough Council and inform him of the placing of the brick at the park.

President McBride gave each Council Member a memo regarding the Appointments to Boards and Committees. He asked each member to make their requests and please return the forms to President McBride by January 6, 2006.

There being no additional business, the meeting adjourned at 5:43 p.m.
