

**CAMP HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING  
2145 WALNUT ST. PROSSER HALL  
CAMP HILL, PA 17011  
July 16, 2008**

President McBride called the public meeting to order at 12:03 p.m. Present were:

Also present were Police Chief Jan Ammons, Mayor Lou Thieblemont, Borough Manager Gary M. Kline, and Borough Secretary Anne Shambaugh.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

There were no public comments at this time.

**INFRASTRUCTURE**

Before proceedings began, Mr. McLemore stated he would recuse himself from the process because he represents one of the bidders in other legal matters.

Mr. Kline introduced Matt Best, the project manager from Gannett Fleming for the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) project. Mr. Best stated there were two (2) complete and responsible bids for the construction portion of the SRTS project: Rogele, Inc. and Leon Wintermyer.

Mr. Best stated the project estimated cost was approximately \$958,000 and the Rogele, Inc. bid was for \$908,598. Mr. Best recommended Council award the bid to Rogele, Inc. contingent upon them meeting all bonding and insurance requirements as well as Penn DOT approval.

- Motion made by Mr. Weber, seconded by Mr. Sledzinski, to accept the bid from Rogele, Inc. for the Base Option as well as Options 1 and 2. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Kline stated the contractors would be working on one side of the street at a time to minimize the inconvenience to the residents.

### **PARKS and RECREATION**

Mr. Edwards stated the deep end of the borough swimming pool has been closed several times this summer due to the filters not working at capacity. He stated the Borough received a quote to replace the filters for \$3,500. He stated this is a non-budgeted item.

Mr. McBride asked Mr. Kline if this was a problem and Mr. Kline stated he didn't know if it was due to the filters or the number of people in the pool at the time they needed to close. Mr. Kline stated this is a stand-alone fund and the money would need to be allocated from the General Fund.

- Motion made by Mr. McLemore, seconded by Mr. Buell, to allocate the funds to replace the filters at the borough swimming pool. After a brief discussion, motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Thieblemont stated Wormleysburg Borough has agreed to join the Boroughs of Camp Hill and Lemoyne in pursuing a Harvest Energy Grant.

Mr. Thieblemont stated preliminary discussions will take place with the West Shore Regional Police Department to consideration consolidation of police, fire and EMT services in the future.

Mr. McLemore asked if Council would consider recognizing the Camp Hill High School Baseball Team for winning the State Championship. He asked if a proclamation could be made as well as recognizing them at a public meeting or event. Mr. McBride stated Council could discuss and plan this recognition at the August meeting.

There being no further information to discuss,

- Motion made by Mr. Weber, seconded by Mr. McLemore, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed unanimously at 12:23 p.m.
