**CAMP HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Council recessed to executive session to discuss a personnel matter at 5:04 p.m.

Borough Council returned to public session at 5:23 p.m.

- Motion made by Mr. Sledzinski, seconded by Mr. Weber, to accept the request from Officer Olsen to retire from the Camp Hill Borough Police Department after 19 years of service effective noon July 30, 2009. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. McLemore expressed his (and council's) appreciation for Officer Olsen's years of service and dedication to the Borough.

Mr. McLemore stated the Camp Hill Fire Police requested the low-ban radios from the Police Department to use in an emergency situation.

- Motion made by Mr. Buell, seconded by Mr. Edwards, to allow the Camp Hill Fire Police to have the low-ban radios, no longer used by the Police Department, to use in emergencies. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Thieblemont stated the Willow Park Plaza is near completion. He asked if Council would consider paying for some of the remaining items for safety purposes. Mr. McLemore asked the Mayor to get the specific information together for next week's council meeting and present it during his report.
