

**CAMP HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL
MINTUES OF THE REORGANIZATION MEETING
2145 WALNUT STREET, PROSSER HALL
CAMP HILL, PA 17011
January 3, 2012**

Mayor Simpson called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m. Present were:

Pursuant to Section 1001 of the Borough Code, the Council of the Borough of Camp Hill met to organize. The newly elected Council members (Donald Edwards, Jr., Peter Robelen and Richard Woodard) presented their Certificates of Election and took their loyalty oath administered by the Honorable Mayor Simpson.

Mayor Simpson asked for nominations for the office of President.

- Motion made by Mr. Woodard, seconded by Mr. Robelen, to nominate Don Edwards, Jr. as Vice-President. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. McLemore requested all committee assignments be submitted to him or Ms. Shambaugh no later than Monday, January 9, 2012.

Mr. McLemore stated he would like to move forward with working with the business community as well as the realtors to focus on the things which may Camp Hill the great Borough it is. Mr. McLemore stated Mr. Edwards and Guerin will focus on the business community and Mr. Woodard will take the lead with the realtors.

HEALTH and SANITATION

Mr. Sledzinski notified Council that DEP is requiring the Borough to re-advertise its Act 537 plan to reflect the change in location of the Spangler Road pumping station. Under the revised Act 537 plan submitted to DEP, the pumping station is on the North side of 581 rather than along Spangler Road.

- Motion made by Mr. Sledzinski, seconded by Mr. Robelen, to approve the re-advertisement of the Borough's Act 537 Plan. Motion passed unanimously.

- Motion made by Mr. Edwards, seconded by Mr. Schultz, to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously at 6:14 p.m.
