149 years ago today, some 5,000 persons gathered at Arlington, VA, now known as Arlington National Cemetery, to observe the first Memorial Day. Two future Presidents were present, Gen. Ulysses S. Grant was an honored guest, and Gen. James A. Garfield delivered the oration. It started after Gen. John A. Logan, Commander of the Union Veterans' Grand Army of the Republic, issued his famous Order No. 11. Gen. Logan said: "The 30th day of May, 1868, is now designated for the purpose of strewing flowers or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country during the late rebellion, and whose bodies now lie in almost every city, village, and hamlet churchyard in the land."
