**RE: Sidewalk & Curbing Maintenance – Chestnut St & Country Club Rd**

Dear Resident:

Over the last twenty four (24) months, the Borough has continued with various Infrastructure Improvement projects including the televising of sewer mains and laterals, the Safe Routes to School program to repair/replace sidewalks and curbing, and paving of numerous streets. As part of these projects, we begin by inspecting the sewer main, sewer laterals, sidewalks and curbing throughout the Borough to determine what sewer lines need repaired and which panels of sidewalk or sections of curbing need to be repaired and/or replaced prior to paving the street.

**Code of the Borough of Camp Hill  
Chapter 176, Article VI, § 176-13.**

*"It shall be the duty of every property owner in the Borough of Camp Hill, at his own expense, .....after notice from the Borough Council, to construct, reconstruct or repair, as such notice shall require, a sidewalk and/or curb, which shall conform to all the applicable provisions of this article, in front of and/or alongside such property."*

During the next few days, the Borough will be in your neighborhood inspecting sidewalks and curbs. The sidewalk panels that need repaired or replaced will be marked with a white dot of paint. The curbing that needs replaced will be marked in the street with a beginning and end point. If you have curbing or sidewalk panels that have been marked, you will have sixty (60) days to make the repairs or replace the broken curbs/panels.

It is the position of the Borough when repairing or replacing curbing, the "new curb" should transition into the existing curb with a gentle slope to avoid a hump in the curb.

There is funding available through a grant with the Borough. The grant application can be found at the website above or at the Borough Office. Thank you for your anticipated, and appreciated, cooperation.
