

**RESOLUTION NO. 2010-01**

**A RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING  
TO UPDATE THE CAMP HILL BOROUGH ZONING ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Act of 1968, P. L. 805, No. 247 as reenacted and amended Article XI of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (hereinafter referred to as MPC) enables governing bodies of municipalities to enter into intergovernmental cooperation implementation agreements to implement comprehensive plans. The Intergovernmental Cooperation Law, 53 Pa.C.S. § 2301, enables municipalities to jointly cooperate in the performance of their respective government functions, powers, or responsibilities pursuant to a written agreement and;

**WHEREAS**, the Camp Hill Borough Council adopted the Imagine West Shore Joint Comprehensive Plan (the "Comprehensive Plan") on February 11, 2009 and;

**WHEREAS**, the Comprehensive Plan recommended the formation of the "West Shore Collaborative" to guide the efforts of Camp Hill Borough, Wormleysburg Borough, and Lemoyne Borough in implementing regional strategies in the Comprehensive Plan and;

**WHEREAS**, the West Shore Collaborative identified updating the zoning and subdivision ordinances of the three Boroughs as the top priority project recommended in the Comprehensive Plan and;

**WHEREAS**, the Camp Hill Borough Council desires to work with Wormleysburg Borough and Lemoyne Borough to update the zoning and subdivision ordinances of the three Boroughs in a manner consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and;

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) provides grant funding to municipalities for updating zoning and subdivision ordinances through the Land Use Planning and Technical Assistance Program (LUPTAP);

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Camp Hill Borough Council authorizes a \$30,000 grant application to DCED to update the zoning ordinances of Camp Hill Borough, Lemoyne Borough, and Wormleysburg Borough in a manner consistent with the Comprehensive Plan. Camp Hill Borough Council further resolves to provide \$5,000 of local funds to support this project.


