

**CAMP HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 04**

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, require Camp Hill Borough (referred to sometimes herein as "municipality") to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

**WHEREAS**, Gannett Fleming, Inc. has prepared a report to the Camp Hill Borough Council entitled "Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update" (Report) which evaluates various alternatives for meeting the projected long-term wastewater treatment needs of Camp Hill Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the alternatives of choice to be implemented by the municipality as described in the Report include the following:

1. Discontinue conveying Borough sewage to the Lemoyne Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) and divert all Borough sewage to the Hampden Township Sewer System for treatment at the Roth Lane WWTP.
2. Construct a new 4.5 mgd capacity pumping facility at Spangler Road with a force main to the point of connection with the Hampden sewer system along Conodoguinet Creek. The new pumping station and force main are to be owned and operated by the Borough.
3. Continue program to rehabilitate the Camp Hill Sewer System to minimize extraneous flows into the System. Follow a basin approach when assigning rehabilitation priorities.
4. Adjust sewer user rates and tapping fees to generate sufficient revenue to fund the proposed sewer system improvements and to satisfy sewer system operation and maintenance requirements.

**WHEREAS**, Camp Hill Borough finds that the Report described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Camp Hill Borough Council hereby adopts and submits to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above referenced Report. The Borough will employ its best efforts, under all the circumstances that will prevail from time to time, to implement the plan as stated therein, and acknowledges the authority of the Department to enforce that schedule pursuant to the Sewage Facilities Act
