**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ELIMINATING MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS TO
THE POLICE PENSION FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2012**

WHEREAS, it is provided by Section 6 of the Act of 1956, May 29, P.L. (1955) 1804, as amended, 53, P.S. 772, also commonly known as "Act 600," that if an actuarial study shows that the condition of the Police Pension Fund of any borough, town or township is such that payments into the fund by members are not required to keep such fund actuarially sound, the governing body of the municipality may, on an annual basis, by ordinance or resolution, reduce or eliminate payments into the fund by members; and


WHEREAS, actuarial valuation of the Borough of Camp Hill Police Pension Fund by the Borough's consulting actuaries has shown that the fund will remain actuarially sound if member contributions continue to be eliminated for the fiscal year of 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of Camp Hill, the governing body of the municipality, that the contributions to the Borough of Camp Hill Non-Uniform Pension Fund provided for in Chapter 48, Article II, Section 48-11 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill Pennsylvania, be and they hereby are waived and eliminated for the fiscal year of 2012; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be construed to modify any other provision of Chapter 48 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill, Pennsylvania in any year subsequent to 2012.
