WHEREAS, the municipality of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, desires to encourage our state legislators, Honorable Senator Patricia Vance and Honorable Representative Glen Grell and

WHEREAS, Title 45 requires local ordinances and meetings must be advertised in newspapers of general circulation to notify the public; however, development in our society and technology have changed the way citizens get their news; and

WHEREAS, the decreased printing schedules of traditional newspapers and their increasing advertising rates have left local officials with no choice but to seek new ways to notify the public; and

WHEREAS, **Senate Bill 733** would amend Title 45 (Legal Notices) affording municipalities the option to electronically publish Legal Notices on their own websites instead of in a newspaper as is currently required by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the municipality of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, heartily recommends your positive support for the various bills enumerated in this resolution.


