Quarterly Meeting Minutes
October 2018**

Q4 Meeting - Thursday, 10/25/2018, Camp Hill Boro Hall 7.30pm

1) Bike/Ped Engineering Study by Simone Collins:

The second workshop on 9/26/18 had great turnout, thanks to better advertising.

Future workshops (all Wednesday 6 pm at Boro Hall): 12/5/2018; 3/6/2019.

At the next workshop, a draft plan will be presented. We should make sure that all proposed paths in Siebert Park are properly fleshed out.

- 2) **Bike/Ped education in schools:** There was a lively meeting at the Pollock center on 8/22/18. Sherri Bowman, Tim Poole, Bob Diehl and Brett Miller were there, as well as Robin Jones of the Lion Foundation. More meetings are envisioned for the future. The impetus was a binder with bike education materials provided to us several years ago by the Philadelphia Bicycle Coalition. We would like to re-start this effort and together with the Camp Hill Schools develop a suitable bike education curriculum. Bob Diehl has been in touch with Jason Minnich of the Mechanicsburg school district. They have a very comprehensive biking program, which is part of the P.E. curriculum.
- 3) **Bike Share** program - expansion to Camp Hill: Luisa met Justine Fabian on 1/11/18 at "Susquehanna Scenes and Sips". Bike Share is hoping to have the funds available by the end of 2018 and will contact the Borough about locations.
- 4) **Bike racks** for businesses:
 - a) Methodist Church (by Fiala) has received a rack, but not installed yet
 - b) Studio C has requested a bike rack but not received or installed. There were some questions about installation / placement of the rack. Matt might have a bike installation manual available.
 - c) Cornerstone is not interested in new bike racks at this time
 - d) The Pennsylvania Bakery has installed a logo rack
 - e) Trinity church has installed a comb rack
- 5) Middle School Bike Club: Rod Bender reported by email that he recently attended the first meeting of the bike club. There was only one student and Nate Jones, teacher from Eisenhower. The student stated that there is possibly more interest. They did a 4-5-mile ride

around town including some of the Goddard Trail and trails in Seibert Park. This could be a good opportunity to get some middle schoolers more interested in biking.
