## **Funding Awarded for Feasibility Study for the Conodoguinet Greenway**

Friends of the Conodoguinet Greenway, in partnership with the Cumberland Conservation Collaborative will be receiving grants for a feasibility study for a trail along the Conodoguinet Creek. Phase One will include portions of the municipalities of East Pennsboro, Camp Hill and Hampden.

The vision for the Conodoguinet Greenway is a continuous recreational path, connecting communities along the Conodoguinet Creek from the Susquehanna River to Carlisle and beyond. The path will follow quiet roads and off-road multi-use trails. The Conodoguinet Greenway will be a natural and scenic resource that enhances the health and quality of life for local residents.

DCNR has approved a grant in the amount of \$36,600.00 but these are funds that must be matched from other sources. A \$17,550.00 Cumberland County Land Partnership Grant has been approved plus each of the municipalities mentioned above has committed to contributing \$3,000.00 for the project. Private donors have contributed \$4,715.00 to date, but an additional \$5,000 in donations is needed for Friends of the Conodoguinet Greenway to receive the full amount of DCNR funding available.
