

# PUBLIC NOTICE

RE: 2021 Sewer Rehabilitation Project

Dear residents of Camp Hill:

You may have received notice that the Borough of Camp Hill has engaged a contractor, Mobile Dredging and Video Pipe of Chester, PA to rehabilitate sections of sewer piping which are nearing the end of useful service life. Mobile Dredging began cleaning lines in December and along with Insituform/Aegion will begin the next phase of the project, sewer lining, during the week of January 25, 2021. This project should be substantially complete by the end of February 2021. Please note that rain and snow could impact the contractor's schedule and completion of the work may be delayed until March 2021. There will be seven (7) areas in which construction work will take place; please see the below map:



N. 24 <sup>th</sup> St., Willow Ave, N. 25 <sup>th</sup> , N. 26 <sup>th</sup> , N. 27 <sup>th</sup> & N. 28 <sup>th</sup> Streets from Cumberland Blvd. to Lincoln St.
Cumberland Blvd. from Creston Rd. to N. 24 <sup>th</sup> St.
Creston Rd. from Merion Rd. to Cumberland Blvd.
Parkside Rd., southern half of
Appletree Rd. from Ridge Rd. to Parkside Rd.
Intersection of Market St. & S. 34 <sup>th</sup> St.

The contractor will make every attempt to keep the streets where work is in progress open but there may be times when traffic will be rerouted. Also, parking will be affected but you will receive a notice the day prior, asking you to not leave any vehicles on your street. Lastly, you may experience disruption of your sewer service. Again, the contractor will give 24 hours of notice prior to any interruptions.
