

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, intends to consider for adoption and to vote upon enactment of an Ordinance entitled and summarized hereinafter at its regularly scheduled meeting to be held on September 9, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., at the Camp Hill Borough Municipal Building. The title of the proposed Ordinance is:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 145 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, "PARKS," ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE BOROUGH PARKS

A summary of the proposed Ordinance is as follows:

The Borough Council recognizes the necessity to amend Chapter 145 to regulate who may access and utilize the Borough parks. As such, the Borough is requiring that all Borough residents possess an issued permit, sticker, or card, when using the facilities in the Borough parks and must accompany any and all guests that are brought to the Borough parks by a Borough resident.
