ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - __

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 145 OF THE CODE
OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, "PARKS," ESTABLISHING
REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE BOROUGH PARKS**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, by virtue of the Laws and Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including the provisions of the Borough Code, et seq., (8 Pa.C.S.A. § 2701, et seq.), as the same may be hereinafter amended, is empowered to regulate recreation places within the borough limits; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the public safety to amend Chapter 145 to regulate who may access and utilize the Borough parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: AMENDMENT TO THE PARKS ORDINANCE.

Chapter 145 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill is hereby amended in the following respects (All references to section numbers are sections from the existing Chapter 145 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill "Parks"):

- A. *Section 145-7(C) Traffic restriction; motorcycles* is amended by deleting the entire body of Section 145-7(C) and replacing it with the following:

"In pursuance of the intention of this section, the Borough Manager is authorized and directed to issue permits, identification stickers and/or electronic or magnetic cards to residents of the Borough of Camp Hill and to erect traffic control devices and appropriate warning signs at the beginning of restricted areas and at such other place or places in the Borough parks as he or she shall determine. A reasonable charge may be made for the issuance of such permits, stickers, and cards. Borough residents must possess said permit, sticker, or card, when using the facilities in the Borough parks. Guests are permitted to use the Borough park facilities when accompanied by a Borough resident, however, it shall be unlawful for a Borough resident to assign, loan, borrow or otherwise temporarily or permanently transfer said permit, sticker, or card to any person, or for any person to accept transfer of the same. Any violation of this Section will result in enforcement by the Camp Hill Borough Police Department and the penalties described in Section 145-9."

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

If any provision, section, sentence, clause or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any other provision, section, sentence, clause or portion of this ordinance which shall continue and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: REPEAL OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

All prior ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. Except as expressly amended hereby, nothing herein shall be deemed to affect or alter the provisions of Chapter 145 of the Borough Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
