

**CAMP HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE REORGANIZATION MEETING
2145 WALNUT STREET, PROSSER HALL
CAMP HILL, PA 17011
January 4, 2010**

Mr. McLemore called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Present were:

Mr. McLemore stated he would like to accomplish the following tasks during the year: the Infrastructure projects, the underpass projects, Siebert Park pool project, Tree City recognition, look for additional cost savings, continue to cooperate with neighboring municipalities including West Shore Council of Governments, solar energy, the selection of electric power providers, what type of bonds are available, the sewage treatment plant will be a big project. We will hold the line on taxes cooperate with the School District for cost savings and increased communications. We will hold a Town Hall meeting every six (6) months. We will have a 125th Anniversary ceremony, we will explore open space opportunities, highlight local businesses in our newsletter and we will complete the hiring of our police force.
