

**CAMP HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL

February 22, 2010**

President McLemore called the public meeting to order at 5:02 p.m. Present were:

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

There was no public comment at this time.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Council recessed to executive session to obtain legal advice from the solicitor and discuss legal matters at 5:04 p.m.

Borough Council returned to public session at 5:35 p.m.

- Motion made by Ms. Donahue, seconded by Mr. Sledzinski, to appoint David Raphael as Special Environmental Counsel at \$300 an hour with the solicitor to negotiate associate and paralegal fees. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. McLemore asked Mr. Malarich if the withdrawal of Wormlesyburg Borough from the Lemoyne Sewer Treatment Plant was a good thing in general with any cost savings. Mr. Malarich stated Lemoyne may be able to use some existing pieces of the existing plant since there will be less sewage to treat.

Ms. Donahue asked if their withdrawal (Wormleysburg Borough) was good for Camp Hill. Mr. Malarich stated it proves Camp Hill's relationship was not the only contentious one with Lemoyne.

Mr. McLemore expressed his thanks and appreciation to Ms. Donahue, Mr. Kline, and Mr. Auxer for working quickly to resolve a snow-plowing complaint. Ms. Donahue stated she would like to buy the members of Public Works lunch for their efforts during the recent storms.

Chief Ammons stated the Police Department has the opportunity to purchase military-style weapons for the officers at a greatly discounted rate. He stated they regularly cost \$800 and the Police Department can purchase them for \$270. He is requesting the use of Forfeiture Funds to purchase four (4) new weapons.

- Motion made by Ms. Donahue, seconded by Mr. Edwards, to purchase four (4) new weapons using approximately \$1100 in Federal Forfeiture Funds. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Sledzinski stated he would like to resign as Council liaison to the Market Street Design Review Committee and recommended Peter Robelen take his position.

- Motion made by Mr. Edwards, seconded by Ms. Donahue, to accept Mr. Sledzinski's resignation from the Market Street Design Review committee and appoint Peter Robelen in his place. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Guerin asked if Council should discuss the appeal filed with the Zoning Hearing Board regarding the billboard at ADM. Mr. McLemore asked if the discussion could be tabled until a later time.

There being no further business to discuss,

- Motion made by Ms. Donahue, seconded by Mr. Guerin, to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously at 5:55 p.m.
