President McLemore called the public meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. Present were:

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Council recessed to executive session to obtain legal advice from the solicitor and discuss legal matters at 6:04 p.m.

Borough Council returned to public session at 6:31 p.m.

- Motion made by Mr. Sledzinski, seconded by Mr. Schultz, for the Borough of Camp Hill to proceed with negotiations with Hampden Township for an intermunicipal agreement for the conveyance and treatment of Camp Hill wastewater to the Hampden Township wastewater treatment plant and Authority. Motion passed unanimously.
- Motion made by Mr. Schultz, seconded by Mr. Edwards, to authorize the Borough engineer to commence the preparation of an amendment to the Borough's Act 537 plan for the conveyance of Camp Hill's wastewater to Hampden Township. After a brief discussion regarding the timing of the filing of the report, motion passed unanimously.

- Motion made by Mr. Robelen, seconded by Mr. Guerin, to authorize the solicitor to investigate and review the Zoning Ordinance regarding electronic billboards and signage as well as the proposed amendments. After a brief discussion, motion passed unanimously.
- Motion made by Mr. Edwards, seconded by Ms. Donahue, to request the Civil Service Commission to remove the following names from the police eligibility list: Prestipino, Boldosser and Sangster. Motion passed unanimously.
- Motion made by Ms. Donahue, seconded by Mr. Edwards, to prepare an offer of employment to Jeffrey Scott Huff for the position of New Patrol Officer. Motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Donahue requested the above motions be mentioned during committee reports at the Wednesday council meeting so residents attending are aware of the decisions made by council.

Mr. Feinour stated the decisions made by council this evening will be forwarded to DEP on Tuesday morning.

Special Counsel David Raphael stated DEP can issue a request from Camp Hill. In addition, DEP will not make any decisions until they have received the 537 plans from Camp Hill, Wormleysburg, and Lemoyne.
