

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 05

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 168 OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL ADOPTING AND ESTABLISHING ANNUAL
SEWER RENTAL FEES

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, that:

Section 1: Section 168-12 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill shall be amended and restated to read as follows:

Imposition of Sewer Rental Charges. All owners of property connected or connecting with the sewer lines and the public sewage system, and all of the owners of property, who may hereafter connect with and use the same, shall pay annual sewer rentals or charges in quarterly installments as hereinafter provided, for the use of such sewage facilities based upon the following schedule of rates:

- (1) Residential: for each single dwelling Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars per year for each occasion. (For the purpose of this section, each dwelling unit of a multiple dwelling shall be deemed a single dwelling, except rooming houses where each tenant occupies only one or two rooms using common toilet facilities.)
- (2) Commercial and Industrial Sanitary Waste: for each connection Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$950.00) per year times the number of E.D.U.'s.
- (3) School: for each connection, Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) per year times the number of E.D.U.'s.
- (4) Church: for each connection, Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) per year times the number of E.D.U.'s.
- (5) Equivalent Dwelling Unit (E.D.U.): shall mean water usage of two hundred twenty-five (225) gallons per day.
- (6) Industrial Waste: additional charges for toxic or strong industrial waste shall be made from time to time as the Council of the Borough of Camp Hill may determine based upon analysis of waste.


Section 2: All other sections and parts of Section 168-12 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 3: All Ordinances and Resolutions or parts thereof, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2011.
