ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF  
CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING  
CHAPTER 168, SECTION 168-10.A, OF THE CAMP HILL BOROUGH CODE  
REGARDING OPENING OF CLOGGED SEWERS

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH  
OF CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, THAT:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough Council  
of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, that Section 168-10.A of the  
Code of the Borough of Camp Hill is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Amendment to Chapter 168, § 168-10.A Opening of closed sewers, to read as  
follows:

**§168-10. Opening of clogged sewers.**

A. In case of any obstruction or clogging of any house connection, building sewer or lateral, as defined in this Chapter, the same may be opened by the employees of the Borough under the direction of the Borough manager, upon application of the owner of the property to the Borough manager, which application shall contain an agreement by such owner to reimburse the Borough for all expenses incurred in such opening, regardless of where the obstruction is located. Should repair or replacement of any part of the house connection, building sewer or lateral be necessary, the owner shall be responsible for the cost of the repair or replacement of the house connection, building sewer or lateral to the sewer main.


**SECTION 2:** All other sections and part of Chapter 168 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION 3:** All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4:** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


