

**ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 0004**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ACCEPTING AS PUBLIC STREET: HILLTOP COURT**

WHEREAS, the Plan entitled "Final Subdivision Plan of Hilltop Village" (the "Development"), is recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Cumberland County, Pennsylvania in Plan Book 93, Page 17; and

WHEREAS, the Developer, Manning Homes, LLC, has completed the installation of Hilltop Court within the said portion of the Development located in Camp Hill Borough, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the requirements of Camp Hill Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Developer has offered for dedication to the Borough said street by duly executed Deed of Dedication.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:


**SECTION 1:** The Borough of Camp Hill ordains and accepts for use as a public street of the Borough of Camp Hill the following:

**ALL** that certain piece or parcel of land situate in the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, known as Hilltop Court as shown on the Plan entitled "Final Subdivision Plan of Hilltop Village", recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Cumberland County, Pennsylvania in Plan Book 93, Page 17, and also shown on the Revised Geometry Plan for Hilltop Village, recorded as Instrument Number 200911254, and which portions of Hilltop Court are more particularly described in the Deed of Dedication of Manning Homes, LLC, dated November 13, 2012, and intended to be recorded concurrent herewith in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cumberland County.


**SECTION 2:** All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


