

ORDINANCE NO. __2-2017__

AN ORDINANCE of the Borough of Camp Hill, County of Cumberland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, adopting and establishing sewer rental fees for the year 2017 and succeeding years until altered by Borough Council.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, County of Cumberland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

Section 1: Section 168-12 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill shall be amended and restated to read as follows:

Imposition of Sewer Rental Charges. All owner of property are connected or connecting with the sewer lines and public sewage system, and all of the owners of property, who may hereafter connect with and use the same, shall pay annual sewer rentals or charges in quarterly installments as hereinafter provided, for the use of such sewage facilities based up on the following schedule of rates.

- (1) Residential: for each single dwelling base rate of One Hundred Fifty Nine (\$159) per quarter, which includes a water usage allowance from 0 to 6,000 gallons per quarter per single dwelling. Water usage beyond \$6,000 gallons per quarter per single dwelling shall be billed at a rate of \$.25 per 100 gallons. (For the purpose of this section, each dwelling unit of a multiple dwelling shall be deemed a single dwelling, except rooming houses where each tenant occupies only one or two rooms using common toilet facilities.
- (2) Commercial and Industrial Sanitary Waste: for each connection Two Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$245) per quarter, which includes water usage 0 to 9,125 gallons per quarter. Water usage beyond 9,125 gallons per quarter shall be billed at a rate of \$1.85 per 100 gallons.
- (3) School: for each connection One Hundred Fifty-Nine (\$159) per quarter. Water Usage beyond 6,000 gallons per quarter shall be billed at a rate of \$.25 per 100 gallons.
- (4) Church: for each connection One Hundred Fifty-Nine (\$159) per quarter. Water Usage beyond 6,000 gallons per quarter shall be billed at a rate of \$.25 per 100 gallons.
- (5) Industrial Waste: additional charges for toxic or strong industrial waste shall be made from time to time as the Council of the Borough of Camp Hill may determine based up analysis of waste.

Section 2: All other sections and parts of Section 168-12 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: All Ordinance and Resolutions or parts thereof, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect January 11, 2017
