

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 71 OF THE CAMP HILL BOROUGH CODE TITLED "ANIMALS" TO DEFINE CERTAIN ADDITIONAL NUISANCES AND PROVIDE FOR A QUICK TICKET PROCEDURE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill ("Council") is empowered by Section 1202(9) of the Borough Code to regulate the running at large of dogs in the Borough in a manner consistent with the Act of December 7, 1982 (P.L. 784, No. 225), known as the Dog Law; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Camp Hill ("Borough") requires that all animals, including dogs, must be under the physical control of their owner or custodian at all times when not confined to the owner's premises; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is authorized to prescribe additional enforcement remedies for violations of Chapter 71, Animals, of the Camp Hill Borough Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill hereby amends Chapter 71, Animals, of the Camp Hill Borough Code as follows:

SECTION 1 – Amend Chapter 71, Animals, Section 71-12, Nuisances, to include the following subsections:

C. All dogs shall be licensed in compliance with the Pennsylvania Dog Law, Act of December 7, 1982 (P.L. 784, No. 225), as amended, 3 P.S. §459-200.

D. All dogs shall be kept in sanitary conditions and owners must keep their property free of excessive dog feces and other animal waste.

SECTION 2 – Insert new Section 71-16, Public Safety Official Notice and Quick Ticket Procedures, to Chapter 71, Animals.

§71-16. Public Safety Official Notice and Quick Ticket Procedures

In addition to other enforcement mechanisms available to the Borough under this Code, the Officer is authorized to issue Public Safety Official Notices for violations of this Chapter and Quick Tickets for nuisances as defined in §71-12. The fines for these violations shall be payable within fifteen (15) days and shall follow the schedule listed below:

Dog not under owner or custodian's physical control	\$25.00
Dog without license required under Dog Law	\$25.00

Presence of excessive feces/animal waste or
unsanitary conditions on property

\$75.00


Failure to pay the Quick Ticket within fifteen (15) days may result in a summary citation being issued through the magisterial district judge's office. Borough Council shall approve changes to Quick Ticket forms and penalty amounts by resolution.
