

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 145, PARKS, SECTION 145-7, TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS; MOTORCYCLES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, that:

Section 1. The Code of the Borough of Camp Hill, Chapter 145, "Parks," §145-7, "Traffic restrictions; motorcycles," is amended to read:

- A. The operation of two- or three-wheeled motor-powered vehicles, including motorcycles and motor scooters, in the Christian L. Sicbert Memorial Park is restricted to the paved roads around and adjacent to the tennis courts and swimming pool, and the operation of said type of vehicles is expressly prohibited on the roads and area north of the parking area at the southeast end of the athletic field.
- B. In pursuance of the intention of this section, the Borough Manager is authorized and directed to issue permits, identification stickers and/or electronic or magnetic cards and to erect traffic control devices and appropriate warning signs at the beginning of restricted areas and at such other place or places in the Borough parks as he shall determine. A reasonable charge may be made for the issuance of such permits, stickers and cards, and it shall be unlawful to assign, loan, borrow or otherwise temporarily or permanently transfer or accept transfer of the same.

All other provisions of Chapter 145, "Parks," shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment by the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill.
