ORDINANCE No. 2021 - 03

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, CUMBERLAND
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 145 OF THE CODE
OF THE BOROUGH OF CAMP HILL, "PARKS," ESTABLISHING PARK
HOURS FOR CERTAIN UNLIT PARKS IN THE BOROUGH**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, by virtue of the Laws and Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including the provisions of the Borough Code, et seq., (8 Pa.C.S.A. § 2701, et seq.), as the same may be hereinafter amended, is empowered to regulate recreation places within the Borough limits; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of public safety to amend Chapter 145 to regulate the hours that Borough residents may access and utilize unlit Borough parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Camp Hill, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: AMENDMENT TO THE PARKS ORDINANCE.

Chapter 145 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill is hereby amended in the following respects (All references to section numbers are sections from the existing Chapter 145 of the Code of the Borough of Camp Hill "Parks"):

- A. *Section 145-3(A) Hours* is amended by deleting the entire body of Section 145-3(A) and replacing it with the following:

"The parks shall be closed from 11:00 p.m., prevailing time, until sunrise except for Schaeffer Park which shall be closed from dusk to dawn. Vehicular traffic in the Christian L. Siebert Memorial Park is prohibited north of the athletic fields between the hours of 9:30 p.m., prevailing time, and sunrise, except for Borough or emergency vehicles and vehicles traveling to and from events sponsored by the Borough or events sponsored by civic or school groups or individuals holding a valid after-hours park use permit."

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

If any provision, section, sentence, clause or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any other provision, section, sentence, clause or portion of this ordinance which shall continue and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: REPEAL OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

All prior ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. Except as expressly amended hereby, nothing herein shall be deemed to affect or alter the provisions of Chapter 145 of the Borough Code of Ordinances.


SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.


This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
